You may choose any or all of the following:

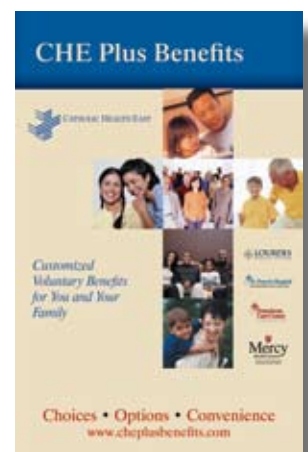
- **Critical Assistance**

You may enroll in Long Term Care, Home & Auto, and Pet Insurance at any time during the year.
